What?

A mirror aware download manager for fetching the dist files in the ports collection.

- ▶ Mirror profiling
- ▶ Duplicate requests
- ▶ Checksum verification
- ▶ Status dump

Why?

- ▶ No good way to pick a mirror
- ▶ Cap max number of simultaneous downloads
- ▶ Torrents
- ▶ Speed restriction



How?

- ▶ dms(daemon)
- ▶ dmget(client)
- ▶ dms workers handle requests using libfetch
- ▶ status updates to client
- ▶ checksum verification

How?

Mirror profiling

- ▶ try untried mirrors
- ▶ samples the download speeds
- ▶ average all the samples collected in last week or last 1024 samples, whichever is minimum
- ▶ rank the mirrors
- ▶ make remarks incase of a failed attempt



How?

Dealing with duplicate requests

- ▶ simultaneous
- ▶ very recently requested requests

Status dump option

- ▶ active downloads (speeds, ETA)
- ▶ mirror profiles

Capsicum blues

- ▶ sandbox the worker?

```
FILE *fetchXGet(struct url *url, char *flags);
```

- ▶ Keep reading the data from the open fd
- ▶ Header parsing
- ▶ Redirection



What's next?

- ▶ Not stable, needs more testing and cleaning up
- ▶ Capsicum integration
- ▶ Torrent support
- ▶ Speed restriction
