- Switched from DocBook XML to AsciiDoctor
  - Markdown-like syntax, easy to get started with
  - Less markup to learn, yet rich styling
  - Transition complete, few issues remain
  - Feedback welcome, work in progress
  - FDP has a rosetta stone page<sup>1</sup> page to ease transition
- Face-lift for our docs, documentation project portal
- New docs .freebsd.org URLs, no more language codes
- Stuff I may have forgotten, but nevertheless important...
